NOW, on this 19th day of November, 2018, this matter comes before the Iowa Alcoholic Beverages Division, upon the Stipulation filed herein by, among and between the Iowa Department of Public Safety and the above-captioned beer permittee. A copy of the Stipulation is attached.

At issue is a complaint against the licensee for a violation of Iowa Code sections 123.2, 123.59, 123.130 and/or 185 Iowa Administrative Code rule 16.7 (sold or provided beer to persons that did not hold the requisite beer permits or retail liquor control licenses and/or served beer for tasting purposes in excess of the volume allowed for an industry member conducted tasting).

The Administrator's Designee **FINDS** that the Stipulation should be accepted in its entirety.

The Administrator's Designee **FURTHER FINDS** that the above-captioned permittee has remitted to this Division the civil penalty of one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) agreed to in the Stipulation.

COMES NOW the Iowa Department of Public Safety, through counsel John Lundquist, Assistant Attorney General, and Mistress Brewing Company, LLC d/b/a Mistress Brewing Company, LLC ("PERMITTEE"), and hereby enter into the following stipulation.

1. **VIOLATION.** The PERMITTEE admits for the purposes of the above-mentioned complaint that on or about March 9, 2018, the PERMITTEE as the holder of a class "A" beer permit sold beer for resale purposes to a person that did not hold a requisite beer permit, wine permit, or liquor control license in violation of Iowa Code sections 123.2, 123.59, 123.30.

2. **ADMINISTRATIVE SANCTIONS.** As an administrative sanction for the violation cited, the PERMITTEE agrees to the following:


CIVIL PENALTY. The PERMITTEE shall pay a fine in the sum of one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00). Full payment of this civil penalty shall be made to the "Iowa Alcoholic Beverages Division" no later than 30 days after the date the Administrator or the Administrator's Designee enters the order approving this Stipulation.

3. **LIMITATIONS OF PENALTY.** The parties agree that no other penalty for the violation listed in paragraph one (1) of this document, other than those listed in paragraph two (2), shall be imposed on the PERMITTEE.

4. **SCOPE OF STIPULATION.** This Stipulation is only applicable to the disposition of Hearing Complaint Number D-2018-00413, filed by the Department of Public Safety against the PERMITTEE on October 29, 2018, and shall not be binding as to any other offenses or violations of the law committed by the PERMITTEE.

5. **ADMINISTRATOR OR ADMINISTRATOR'S DESIGNEE APPROVAL.** The administrative sanctions imposed pursuant to this Stipulation are subject to the approval of the Administrator or the Administrator's Designee of the Iowa Alcoholic Beverages Division. The failure of the Administrator or the Administrator's Designee of the Alcoholic Beverages Division to accept the proposed Administrative Sanctions as an appropriate sanction for the offenses charged in the pending hearing complaint shall render this Stipulation null and void without force or effect upon any party.
